BIG SKY COUNTRY STATE FAIR COMPETITIVE EXHIBITS VISION:

To engage the community with a competitive-rich environment, educating visitors about the exhibits, providing an attractive welcoming exhibit environment, and showcasing the traditional skills and creativity of Montana.

The Culinary Arts Superintendent coordinates the Culinary Arts Department for the Big Sky Country State Fair, July 17-21, 2019. This is a temporary position under the supervision of the Competitive Supervisor. Duties include updating the department classes for the Competitors' Guide, recruiting 1-2 judges, supervising judging and display of entries, recruiting volunteers if necessary, and running a daily culinary contest, demonstration or workshop during the Fair.

Hours: February to June – 1-2 hours/month (1 hour-long meeting/month)

During BSCSF July 14-22, 2019 – minimum of 5 hours/day between Noon and 10pm

Pay is a \$400 stipend
