#### 5.0 Interim Events

5.1 Utility Fee for 4-H, County Departments

Lori Cox

Revisiting issue as commissioners are concerned about user fee vs. utility fee Discussion: (Utility fee and cancellation policy)

- JaNaie' Veca-letter from Kelton Jensen, 4-H Agent:
  - Understands utility fee, concerned about cancellation fee
- Brent Donnelly-Interested in dialogue to help make this situation work for everyone
- Lori Cox-2 different issues-since 4-H came "home" to Fairgrounds:
  - First-Utilities have increased
  - Second-Cancellations and no shows (see handout).
- Dennis Voeller-Fairgrounds has one operations staff for the full Fairgrounds; schedule is developed one month in advance. Every change made to the calendar affects staff.
- Brent-Reversely, 4-H has been locked out of buildings on multiple occasions
- Dennis-Schedule is developed between JaNaie' and himself
- Brent asked for history of 4-H use of the Fairgrounds
- Ann Marie Moran—Years ago 4-H groups paid full fees, part fees & barter for volunteer hours (child-labor laws caused shut down of this program); a few years ago the Fair Board made the decision to not charge 4-H; however they have also made the decision to start charging to cover heat and electricity
- Brent-Understands that there is a \$300-\$500 cancellation fee
- Lori read cancellation policy; if there is a no-show they are charged for their time that was scheduled (hourly events are charged hourly)
- Brenda-Weather is taking into consideration for arena events (horses)
- Brent-What are the consequences if the Fairgrounds doesn't get door unlocked or someone else is in their building?
- JaNaie'-policy says "whatever is greater" which lead them to the \$500 fee
- Dennis-It is a \$10/hour user fee which includes utilities and some maintenance. If it was called a utility fee there would be an argument that they didn't use the utilities.
- Dennis-If renting by the hour, a 24-hour notice is needed to cancel with no fee.
- Lori-If renting by the day, 60 day notice is needed.
- JaNaie'-Suggested that Fair Board clarify the rules.
- Lori will get document to Kelton who can disseminate to 4-H groups.
- Joe-Kelton's concerns were if they can be bumped, why should there be a cancellation fee; also there are only 3 4-H groups causing the abuse.
- Ann Marie-This will help the groups be more accountable
- Jim-Kelton spoke very highly of relationship with Fairgrounds
- County departments will also pay \$10/hour fee
- Ann Marie-Expressed frustration with perception that 4-H believes Fairgrounds is trying to force them out; the Fair Board is doing everything they can to help 4-H prosper

- Had a meeting with Cynde at HR. They re-worked the job description and asked for 5 years experience instead of 1 year and GED to bump the pay up in the salary band
- Our job descriptions do not fit County descriptions
- Nick Borzak suggested that other County employees may have some time they can help the Fairgrounds or we could hire a cleaning company to do janitorial work
- Express Services would like to flip different people each day or charge us \$5,000 to have the same person return every day
- Another option is to have someone live on the grounds
- Open for other ideas
