

CULINARY ARTS SUPERINTENDENT POSITION

Big Sky Country State Fair - Gallatin County Fairgrounds

The Big Sky Country State Fair is looking for a creative individual that is passionate about Culinary Arts to assist the Gallatin County Fairgrounds in a superintendent role. This individual is someone who wants to help continue the tradition of the Culinary Arts Division as a Competitive Event at the Big Sky Country State Fair.

The Culinary Arts Superintendent works closely with the Gallatin County Staff members to coordinate administrative tasks of the Culinary Arts Department for the Big Sky Country State Fair season.

Hours: February to June – 1-3 hours/month including, if necessary, one hour-long meeting/month with Fairgrounds staff. During the Big Sky Country State Fair, July 20-24, 2022 – as needed to properly staff the display area during the fair.

This position will be responsible for the following duties; updating the Culinary Arts Department portion of the Competitors' Guide, brainstorm with marketing coordinator to promote the department, recruit volunteers to assist with display setup, secure qualified individuals for judging.

During the week of fair the superintendent manages the check-in of entries (Monday Prior to Fair), keeps a record of all exhibits judged and awards given (book provided), arrange for and schedule volunteers to watch over the department, educate visitors and answer questions about the department exhibits.

Monday following fair duties include the check-out of all entries and ensure prizes have been awarded, submit Volunteer Time Cards, complete a department evaluation sheet within 30 days after the fair.

This is a stipend position.
