

There are certain things that are synonymous with "Summer Fair" and livestock animals is one of them. Head over to the First Security Bank Barns Wednesday – Saturday to view sheep, swine, beef and dairy cows, goats, rabbits, and poultry!

Keep an eye out for our new animal fun fact posters at the barns to learn about these great animals and check out the schedule on the next page to find a show in the Murdoch's Show Ring under the Ag West Credit Services Tent.

For the safety of our guests and the animals, we've rearranged the Barn area to have only 2 entrances. Please be aware that these entrances close nightly at 9pm so that the animals can rest. The barns will also be closed on Sunday for animal processing transport schedule.











Animal Safety Tips

- These are real livestock animals treat them with respect and give them space. If you are looking for the Petting Zoo, it's in the Haynes Pavilion by A Gate
- Be sure to wash your hands before and after you visit the barns. Sanitizer is available at barns and handwashing stations are available on Food Row
